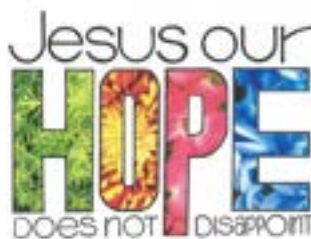

Our Mission

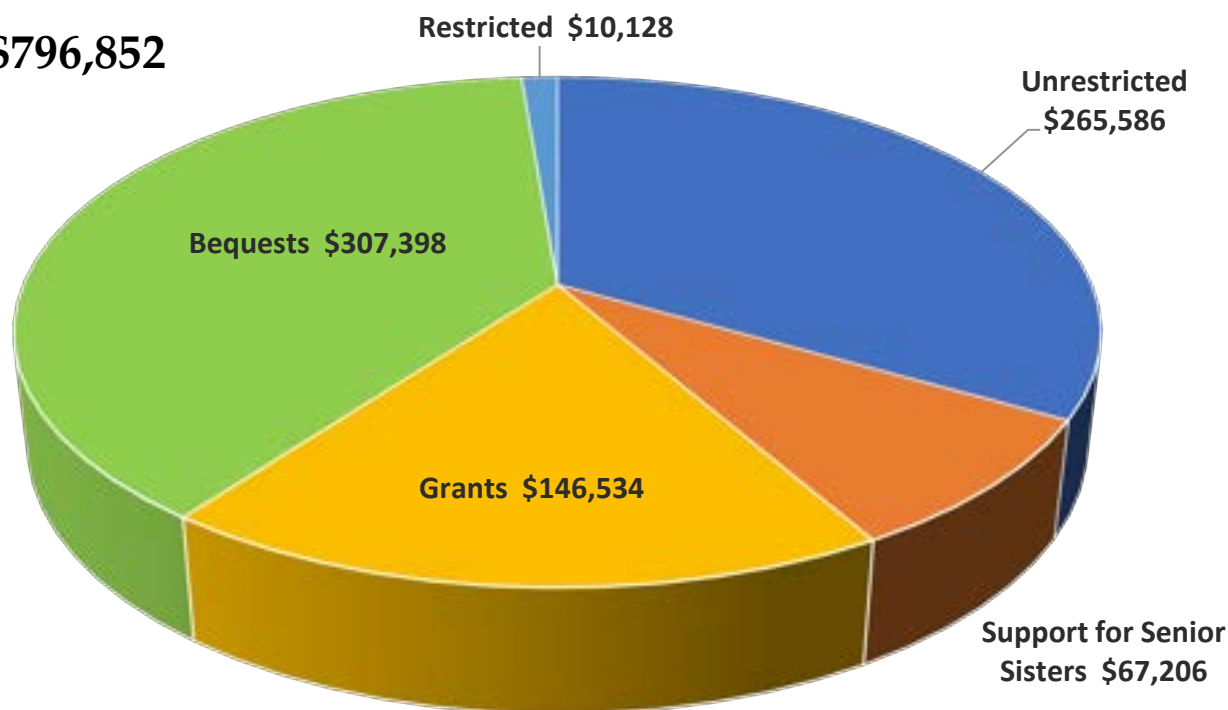

BEQUESTS

Planned gifts through wills, trusts, and estate plans were used to support all areas of our mission. These gifts were given by seven individuals and provided \$307,398 to support all of our ministries.

UNRESTRICTED

Unrestricted donations provided additional funding, which was utilized to address the most essential needs for all areas of our missions.

RESTRICTED

Restricted gifts received from individuals and organizations were used to fund specific areas of interest that were designated by the donors. These contributions supported areas of mission such as the Jankola Library, Maria Hall renovations, St. Francis Center, the Basilica and Adoration Chapel.

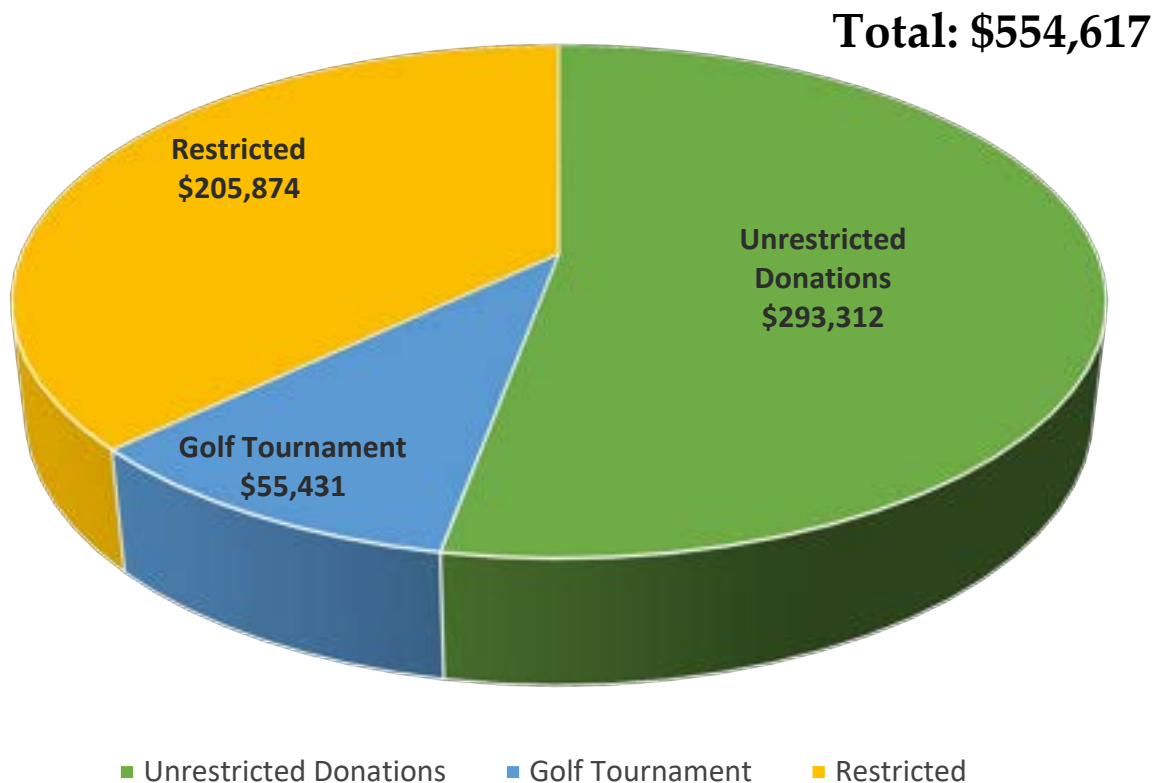
SUPPORT FOR SENIOR SISTERS

Our Sisters living at Maria Hall continue to carry out our mission through their daily prayers. Gifts designated to support our Sisters were used to provide compassionate care, programming, items of enrichment and renovation projects that improve their quality of life.

GRANTS

Grants are donations that are awarded to organizations for a specific purpose or project. In 2025, the Sisters of Saints Cyril and Methodius received \$146,534 that supported designated projects within the community.

UNRESTRICTED

These contributions provide the flexibility to address the community's most pressing needs and to enhance the quality of life for our residents. Unrestricted funding supports a wide range of initiatives, including building maintenance and improvements, technology updates, compassionate care for residents in need, and the purchase of essential medical equipment across all levels of care.

RESTRICTED

Many generous donors chose to direct their gifts toward specific projects and initiatives that are meaningful to them. These contributions made it possible to complete important improvements and enhancements throughout our community, including repairs to the Chapel roof, the creation of a bocce ball court, bathroom renovations and the construction of an outdoor pavilion. Additional restricted gifts supported a variety of enriching activities that brought joy, engagement, and connection to our residents.

GOLF TOURNAMENT

Our 2025 Golf Tournament, held on September 19 at Frosty Valley, brought together supporters for a day of fellowship, friendly competition, and generosity in support of our mission. This year's event focused on raising funds to create gift shops in both Maria Joseph Manor and Emmanuel Center, and thanks to the incredible support of our sponsors, golfers, and donors, we raised \$55,431 toward this initiative. We look forward to welcoming everyone back for the 2026 tournament on Friday, September 18, 2026, at Frosty Valley.
